



TUSCARORA TACTICAL TRAINING, LLC RANGE AND SAFETY RULES 10/1/11

The following Range Rules and Regulations are established to insure safety and conduct for students and guests on the school's property as well as safety for our neighbors and the surrounding community. All students are required to enforce these rules. EVERYONE is a Range Safety Officer

The Owners will review all reports of range violations and take one of the following actions:

1. No Action;
2. Verbal warning
3. Immediate dismissal; including loss of tuition or other fees.

SAFETY: Safety First!! Safety will always be first and foremost for all activities on the range/property.

COURTESY AND RESPECT: All instructors, owners, range masters and fellow students are to be treated with courtesy and respect. We are all on the same team and will treat each other as such.

ON THE PROPERTY BEFORE/AFTER CLASS:

If you are wearing your concealed handgun when you arrive, leave it on and leave it alone. Do NOT handle your gun anywhere on the facility unless directed to do so by an instructor. If you were not wearing your carry gun when you drove through our front gate, do NOT put it on and load it in the parking area. Put it in a case or bag or in your holster and bring it to the classroom unloaded. Simply stated, leave all guns in the condition they are in when you arrive.

Do NOT handle your gun anywhere on the facility unless directed to do so by an instructor.

Do NOT handle your guns in the classroom unless directed to do by an instructor.

The ONLY place you may handle your firearm is the firing line.

RANGE RULES:

- All guns are always loaded.
- Never let your muzzle cover anything you are not willing to kill, destroy, or buy.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target.
- Be sure of your target and what is beyond, around, and next to it.
- The Range master/Instructor has complete control over all range activities.
- Due to provisions in our insurance and out of respect for the neighbors, no incendiary or explosive devices may be used on range property. IE: Tracers, Tannerite.
- Only shoot at designated targets.
- Steel targets must be engaged in a safe manner and may not be engaged from closer than 10 yards.
- No alcohol is permitted on any range.
- The use of illegal drugs is forbidden on Range property. (Automatic expulsion).
- Be aware of any situation that might cause any shot to ricochet unsafely. Including over the berm.
- Any person making use of or being present on the range wear appropriate eye and ear protection.
- Absolutely no hunting is allowed on range property.
- Do not trespass on adjacent properties, including the railroad.
- Students agree to take responsibility for any damage to the range, equipment and surrounding property due to any action on their part. (Beyond normal wear and tear)
- The Range Officer or Owners shall not be responsible for personal property left on the range property.
